ABOUT THE POSITION

This position will involve driving a 3.5T vehicle to deliver goods whilst receiving internal and external training to become a **QUALIFIED CAT C DRIVER**. This position will suit someone who has a full UK driving licence, is enthusiastic, has a flexible attitude and ideally has multi-drop experience. You will be eager to learn and have a desire to obtain a CAT C / Class 2 licence.

Responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

- Driving 3.5T company vehicles to deliver food and disposable goods to customers in a safe and responsible manner

- Bulk picking items from the back of a lorry and carrying goods to point requested by the customer
- Collecting cash and/or cheques from customers for the goods delivered
- Recording temperature of the vehicles chiller and freezer ensuring temperatures are kept within the critical limits, reporting any issues to the Transport Management team.
- Driving safely and in a manner to minimise wear and tear.
- Returning run sheets and cash collections to the Accounts department
- On return to the warehouse take undelivered goods to the relevant area in the warehouse
- Completing relevant paperwork and returning it to the Transport department
- Ensuring your vehicle is kept clean and tidy inside and out
- Assisting warehouse personnel with vehicle loading where necessary
- To pass on any orders or messages from customers to a telesales operator and transport management team.
- Completing internal and external driver training

WHAT TRAINING WILL BE PROVIDED?

Internal Training –

Driving: You will be assigned with a driver, accompanying them on the road to receive training on multi-drop delivery, customer service and maintaining company vehicles. On completion of external training the company will conduct an assessment of your skills and will grade you as follows, Pass, Needs Improvement or Fail. Further internal training will then be provided where required.

External Training – The company will pay for you to receive external CPC and CAT C training which will qualify you to drive LGV. External training will commence within 12 months of your start date as a 3.5T Driver. The training fees will be covered by Charles Saunders Ltd but should you leave within 5 years you will be required to repay the fees on a sliding scale, full details / terms and conditions will be provided to you if an offer of employment is made.
